Hard-to-Recycle Items

Paper as listed (separate by type):

NO CHARGE

- Must be separated by color: clear, green, brown only
 - Remove lids and corks; lids can be recycled with scrap metal
- No blue glass bottles

Glass Jars and Bottles only:

No specialty glass; sheet glass, automotive glass, ceramics, mirrors, Pyrex, candles, "Plug-in" -type air fresheners

Cardboard (corrugated, chip board, cereal boxes)

- Office/White Paper (shredded OK; staples and paperclips OK)
- Mixed paper (colored paper, file folders, junk mail, magazines, phone books)
- Newspaper (black and white, color inserts)

NO plastic covers or 3-ring binders

Tires: *members receive discount on tire disposal

Passenger/Light Truck Tires: Tractor Trailer (19.5, 22.5, 24.5)

Agricultural/farm tractor (based on size):

Highway/construction/heavy equipment (based on size):

Bulbs and fixtures: NO CHARGE CFL (compact fluorescent bulbs) Specialty bulbs: fluorescent tubes 4ft or smaller, u-bend, halogen, HID, high pressure sodium, LED \$1.00/each Fluorescent tubes longer than 4ft \$2.00/each Ballasts (PCB or non-PCB) \$5.00/each

Other:

Refrigerant Appliances (frig, freezers, A/C, dehumidifiers, etc.) \$20.00/ unit Scrap Metal (non-refrigerant appliances, propane tanks, tools, car parts, microwaves, misc.) NO CHARGE Lead Acid Batteries; Uninterruptible Power Supplies (UPS) marked with Pb NO CHARGE Used Motor Oil, (No other automotive fluids or chemicals) NO CHARGE

Not Accepted: Household trash, anything that's mostly wood, plastic, glass, or ceramic:

- Batteries: single use, alkaline, rechargeable household and tool batteries, loose lithium ion laptop batteries, etc.
- Furniture: wood, fabric, mattresses, box springs
- Incandescent Light Bulbs
- Ink/toner cartridges
- Paints, Household Hazardous Waste*

- Plastic: no plastic of any kind: jugs, bottles, buckets, containers, toys, vinyl
- Pianos, organs
- Medical Equipment
- Small appliances (coffee pots, blenders, mixers, lamps)
- Vacuum cleaners, rug scrubbers
