After reviewing the July 2020 meeting minutes, Chester Lockwood moved to approve the minutes as written, seconded by Dan Hosac and all were in favor.


Discussion of Proposed Dollar General Store

They are all Upper Burrell residents. They were concerned about the location of the proposed building to their adjacent property along Dewey Drive. After a discussion the residents were told the Commission had not as yet received a formal submission of the proposed store and that a public hearing would need to be held to discuss a zoning revision to include such a store in the Commercial zone. The Commission suggested checking in the with the township secretary occasionally to see if there has been any submission from Dollar General.
