The Chief stated that as for the jake brake there is a restriction thru PennDot that if the road has a 4% or higher grading you cannot restrict this. Chief stated in the areas along Turkey Ridge Road the grade ranges from 6% to 14% and if there were to be an accident this could come back on the township. Walker asked if the 73 calls included 911 calls the Chief replied yes along with walkins.
